The Seamón Family Foundation, Inc. (SFF) was created as a 501(c)3 nonprofit in 2020 out of the Covid-19 pandemic, to address the reduction of art, literacy, and financing programming and support amongst youth and their parents in underserved communities.

The Seamón Family Foundation proposes the Exploring the Art & Science series — the dynamic, hands-on learning experiences designed to connect the excitement of individual interest areas within the arts and sciences with the business skills essential for long-term success. These 5-day intensives will immerse participants in interactive workshops, simulations, real-world contract analyses, and more.

By utilizing a community development approach, the Seamón Family Foundation (SFF) partners with educational institutions, agencies, organizations, and businesses that share our commitment to Social & Financial Investment in Arts, Literacy & Culture. Through youth, parent, community outreach education and empowerment, we work with partnering agencies to increase arts and literacy programming, as well as mental health awareness, the prevention of bullying and hate, environmental awareness, and more.



The entertainment company, Seamón Enterprises and Entertainment (SE&Eco) partners, produces, and organizes outreach programs, community events. SE&Eco's literary works include "Daddy's Big Secret, Jordan Learns the Truth" (DBS) and "The Little Bird and The Magic Oracle" (TLB) books, written by dyslexic author, Jermaine Seamón. Jermaine's books have received various awards and honors, have been featured twice at the International Dyslexia Association's Dyslexia Dash, as well as in private and public book signings in Georgia, North & South Carolinas, Chicago, and Philadelphia. DBS is also available in the DeKalb and Fulton County Library Systems, further emphasizing Jermaine's commitment to literacy and representation.

With his young daughter Jordan by his side, they released DBS, their first children's book.

DBS is a powerful tool for kids, parents and educators, that inspires acceptance and awareness around learning differences, similar to difficulties Jermaine faced as a child. DBS encourages educators to foster classroom inclusion and encourage peer support, while it also helps parents recognize signs, start conversations and find support, but most importantly DBS helps children to understand themselves, build confidence, and helps young children develop empathy to better understand and support their peers.

The story introduces readers to Justice, a timid girl who forms an unlikely friendship with a fearless little bird named Jordan. Together, they embark on a journey through natural and fantastical realms, discovering adventure, courage, and the transformative power of imagination. Jermaine masterfully used his daughter Jordan's personality to shape both characters: Jordan's fearlessness shines through the little bird character, while her fears and insecurities are reflected in Justice's character, allowing readers to see how bravery and vulnerability can coexist, lead to long-lasting friendship and extraordinary adventures. TLB fosters an appreciation of friendship, nature, teaches problem-solving and resilience, inspires imagination, promotes family bonding, and encourages curiosity, and exploration.

Jermaine is currently working on his third book and stage play.

In previous seasons we have organized the Atlanta Philly weekend scholarship - fundraiser event at Lake Pavilion in Griffin, Ga, and the Atlanta SummerFest weekend at Pittsburgh Yards in Atlanta, Ga, where more than 100 authors, artists, film makers, and vendors were highlighted. Both events also included youth panels, performances, and giveaways. We have a strong list of supporters, website subscribers and a social media presence that allows us to engage with our supporters and promote our projects effectively.



Last season SE&Eco facilitated the "Exploring the Art, and Science of Stage and Screen" (EASSS) program, to increase reading and financial literacy, as well as raise awareness within the career fields of science, technology, engineering, arts, and science (STEAM) through our mentors and partners from the business and entertainment industries. The program featured the production of the stage play, "Meet Grandma Polly & The Big Rig Kids," adapted from "Meet The Big Rig Kids" children's book series. Rehearsals were 120-days, and the play debuted its 2-day weekend production in Atlanta to 2 sold-out shows.

The program incorporated speakers and industry leaders that provided workshops for adult and youth participants, who (youth) also received financial literacy resources and scholarship funded bank accounts to deposit their earnings into from Associated Credit Union.

## Here are a few concept of how a joint SFF/SEE BookFair could be structured:

There could be a specific focus on one or two authors, providing a brief biography, excerpts from their work, and reflections on their contributions to literature and culture, inviting local writers, especially young and emerging voices, to submit their work for consideration, fostering a-sense of ownership and pride within the community.

There is also an option to collaborate with local visual artists to include illustrations or cover art, further supporting local talent.

Authors and artists can read passages from their book, or provide testimonials of their artistry during the fair, to encourage discussions on diversity in art and literature, and the importance of representation.
